

## Project communication

How do you explain better the key design decisions of an infrastructural, architectural or urban design project than by showing the finished work from a human perspective?

Taking your audience for a walk through your designed work in 3D saves a lot of time compared to explaining technical 2D drawings or still artist impressions, and will earn you compliments from the stakeholders for your innovative presentation method. Plans are accepted or sold sooner, winning time and money for your project.

But also in the design stage 3D visualization will add to the efficiency, possible building mismatches are detected early and design decisions can be easily made using the digital terrain model rather than having to go on site all the time. We suggest: start early with 3D visualization and let the model grow with the project. All stages of the project will benefit.
